Military Enlistment Standards: Drug or Alcohol Use

Emphasize to the applicant that any drug use (including marijuana) after the date of the interview is considered post-orientation and will render him/her ineligible for the Air Force.3.10.4.3.5.1. If the applicant indicates previous use of marijuana, amphetamines, barbiturates, or non- prescription anabolic steroids, continue the interview.

The first time an applicant fails the drug screening, he or she has to wait 90 days and then may reapply with a waiver at the discretion of the particular branch of the military to which he or she is applying. Be advised: This sounds like a quick and easy process, but it's not guaranteed.

Drug Test (Positive) Waiver and Waiting Periods

In one recent memo, the Army re-affirmed a fairly new policy that allows the organization to accept recruits who admit to using marijuana in the past. Under the new policy, anyone who says they haven't used cannabis for four or more years prior to their recruitment can still enter the service.
